A passage from Herman A. Hassinger, the Architect of the church on April 24, 1983....

Our building is a deliberate design to return to the "gathered together" worship of the Apoststolic Church.

The Church is the people. The church building is only a man made convenience that exists to service the people in their act of corporate worship. There is a table altar as the center of worship. The congregation is in a gathered seating arrangement. In the center our Pastor leads this family in common worship. The building reflects directly an increased emphasis on the sharing of worship, joy, and celebration. This is a healthy return to the earlier tradition. The congregation is deliberately set face to face. We meet as a family across the table in a single unifying space for the congregation, the Word, and the Sacraments.
